In <b>Part I: MAT</b>, there will be 50 questions and 45 minutes. In <b>Part II: SAT</b>, again 2 tests, (i) Language Test – 40 questions &amp; 45 min and (ii) Aptitude Test – 90 questions &amp; 90 min (35-Sc, 20-Math and 35-S Sc).</p> <p><b>STAGE - II</b> Exam at the <b>National level</b> comprise of (a) Mental Ability Test (MAT) and (b) Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT). In <b>Part-I: MAT</b>, there are 50 questions and 45 min. In <b>Part-II: SAT</b>, there are 2 tests, (i) Language Test – 50 questions &amp; 45 min and (ii) Aptitude Test – 100 questions &amp; 90 min (40-Sc, 20-Math and 40-S Sc).</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> The items in the MAT and SAT are multiple choice questions. Each question has 4 alternatives, out of which the candidate has to select only one correct answer.
